NATIONAL. We want you to have a fun & safe National Weekend.

PLEASE ABIDE BY THESE SIMPLE RULES:

- We will park you as you arrive, in the next available space, in the area of your choice. You may not save spots for people who will arrive later. Camping spaces are no wider than 20'.
- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS. All campers/haulers over 20' in length should be equipped with a fully functioning fire extinguisher.
- No campfires please. Small contained cooking fires are permitted no larger than 20" diameter.
- Quiet time is 11:00 pm nightly. No loud generators after this time. **CURFEW IS AT MIDNIGHT.**
- No campsites, tents or awnings permitted within 20' of the . motocross track fence.
- We do not permit pets, fireworks, glass beverage containers, kegs, . scaffolding or weapons. All vehicles are subject to search.
- Gates close daily from midnight to 6:00 am. You may leave after this . time, but many not re-enter until 6:00 am. Please plan accordingly.
- Gate prices do not change until Midnight. If you arrive prior to midnight, you will be charged that day's admission.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times. If you leave the facility, you must • have it on in order to re-enter. This is your gate ticket. Do not take it off.
- All vehicles on the premises overnight must have a camping permit. •
- STAY OFF THE TRACK. The racetrack is off limits to spectators. Only registered racers and authorized personnel are permitted on the race track. No one is permitted on the racetrack at night.
- DO NOT take the banners. Banners and event signage are the Private Property of the Promoter. Removal of these items is illegal and . punishable by law. You will be prosecuted for theft. Don't be a thief!
- No pit bikes, guads, scooters, golf carts, etc. Race bikes may be ridden at a walking pace to and from your moto only. •
- No drones or remote control aircrafts permitted. •
- No bicycles allowed in Pro Pits or Sponsor Village on Saturday race day.

OTHER EVENT INFORMATION:

- Search Policy: All vehicles are subject to search at any time. If any . fireworks, glass containers, or other prohibited items are found, you may remove them from the property yourself, or we will dispose of them for you. We are not responsible for the safe return of any contraband removed.
- SANITATION. Please use our trash receptacles. If you need trash bags, • you can get them from the front gate.
- **GENERAL INFORMATION is located at the Main Gate.**
- **RIDER INFORMATION is located at Rider Registration.**
- WILL CALL is located at the Speedway (Friday 9AM 5PM) & at the . Main Gate (Saturday 7AM - 2PM).
- FIRST AID is located at the Ambulance Station.
- SECURITY is headquartered at the Main Entrance. •
- LOST & FOUND is located at Rider Registration. •
