



Thank you for your entry for the **RedBud 125 All Star Race**, Round 7 of the 2019 Lucas Oil Pro Motocross Championship, brought to us by **RedBud MX**. Please confirm your name, number, and bike brand on the attached Rider Roster, and advise the MX Sports Race Official immediately of any changes.

Registration & Credentials:

Although you are pre-entered, you must register and confirm your entry at Will Call/Industry Services, located near Gate 8. You will be required to present a current AMA membership and sign the Release and Waiver of Liability. If you are a minor, your parents will be required to be present and complete the Minor Release.

Industry Services Hours:

Friday: 9 am - 5 pm

Saturday: 7 am - 2 pm

Your entry includes an MX Sports Pro Racing Pass, good for all day paddock access Friday and Saturday. You will receive this Pass when you check in at Industry Services, and may also buy additional guest passes at the rate of \$60 each if needed. These passes are only available to pro racers and the 125 All-Star racers. Please note that your 125 class entry fee does not include full gate admission to the event weekend. You and any guests will need to purchase wristbands and camping passes, if needed, from RedBud as usual.

Parking:

125 All Star parking in the Pro Paddock is from 3pm until 11pm Friday. All occupants of your vehicle must have an MX Sports Pro Pass in order to enter the Lot, so be sure to stop at Industry Services before parking.

Camping:

If you are camping in the amateur pits until Friday, **you'll need to move to the pro pits in order to race Saturday.** Directions: exit the main gate and turn right. Go ½ mile and turn right onto Miller Rd. Go ½ mile and turn right onto Main Street. The Gate D entrance to the pro pits will be on your right.

There's no camping in the pro pits Saturday night. Anyone wishing to stay is welcome to exit the pro pits and camp outside the paddock.

Qualifiers/Practice:

Friday Qualifiers will not be held for this event, as the number of entries was limited to 40. In lieu of Qualifiers, we will conduct a 15-minute 125 All Star Practice session Friday as close to 2pm as possible. Keeping in mind that some 125 All Star racers will be participating in the Friday amateur event, practice will be scheduled based on the Friday race order so riders don't miss a moto to practice. Riders should pre-stage at the MX Sports Semi in the pro pits, where an MX Sports Pro Official will place a Practice Sticker on the upper left corner of your number plate. This sticker will validate your permission to practice and you can proceed to staging after receiving it. Friday Practice is optional.

Racing:

Saturday racing will consist of one practice session and one 4-Lap moto. Riders will stage again at the MX Sports Pro Racing Semi. Gate picks will be based on computer random draw. Remember – this is a 125cc class; no 144cc or 150cc big bores.

Awards:

Awards will be given to the Top 3, plus \$500 in contingency VISA cards, compliments of our friends at *Throttle Syndicate*. In addition, *Hoosier Tires* will award both the class winner and the top competitor using Hoosier Tires with one free tire.
